I was born in 1964. I graduated from the University of Architecture in Venice, IUAV in 1989.

From 1990 to 1991 I worked in Naples, at the Francesco Venezia office's, and I have participated in the drafting of numerous projects, exhibitions and international competitions.

Since 1992 I have worked in my private practice as an architect, and I took part to national and international competitions, during that time. I received several awards. And I was invited to exhibit my designs in numerous exhibitions.

Since 2015 I have been an associate Professor in the Urban and Architectural Design at the University of Catania, based in Syracuse, where I was teaching and researching. I exhibited my works in several national and international publications and exhibitions. My architectural research has taken part in various exhibitions, conferences and conventions. I've exhibited my works in more editions of the International Architecture Exhibition at Biennial in Venice, at the Triennale di Milano.

I've won several national and international competitions:

In 2010 I won the first prize for an international competition "Progetto artistico-architettonico di rifunzionalizzazione di due gru nel porto di Palermo".

In 2009 I won first prize for the realization of the harbour station in Syracuse.

I received several awards and honors:

In 2015 I won the national prize "*Italian Architect Prize 2015*", from National Council of Architects, Planners, Landscape Architects and Conservationists.

In 2014 I've received by the Association Environment Climiti a "award for career". First Edition Florida SLOW 2014. International Event of joyful cultural resistance

In 2013 I won the first prize for an international competition "ARCH & STONE'13" Stone Architecture of the New Millennium International Award Architecture in Stone 2Nd Edition.

In 2012 I was selected (Phase I - II) for the Mies van der Rohe Award. Barcellona 2013.

In 2012 I won the Gold Medal for Italian Architecture 2012, which is awarded from La Triennale di Milano in cooperation with the Cultural Heritage Ministry and with MADE Expo.

In 2008 I won a prize “Premio Innovazione e Qualità Urbana” ed. 2008, Rimini Fiera EuroP.A. and “Premio G.B. Vaccarini” for architecture and interior design.

In 2006 I won a prize Gubbio 2006 sponsored from the National Historical Art Centres.

In the 2004 I won the International Architectural Prize, Dedalo Minosse, under 40. I was one of the finalist's and the Premio Nazionale Accademia di S. Luca (2004).

In 2003 I won some prizes like: “Il Principe e l'Architetto”, the “Premio Internazionale Architetture di Pietra 2003”, I was one of the finalist's for the award “Medaglia d'Oro della Triennale di Milano”
