Call for Participation in 1° CHerIDDOC International Workshop

This call is open to students interested in participating in the activities carried out within the **CHerIDDOC – Cultural Heritage Digital Documentation project** (2025-1-EL01-KA220-HED-000362317)

The project involves the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), the University of Bamberg, and the University of Catania, and aims to promote advanced knowledge and practical skills in the field of digital documentation of cultural heritage.

The workshop – fully funded by the project – will take place from 22 to 28 July 2026 and focuses on providing hands-on experience in digital cultural heritage documentation at Ancient Messene, Greece. This initiative offers participants the opportunity to gain practical experience with innovative digital tools, collaborate in international teams, and engage with students and experts from across Europe.

Target students and available places

Eight (8) places are open to students from the Department of Civil Engineering and Architecture of the University of Catania, enrolled in the third, fourth, or fifth year of the Master's Degree Programmes in "Building Construction and Architectural Engineering" and "Architecture".

Additional places are reserved for students from the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA) and the University of Bamberg with a similar academic background.

Accommodation will be shared.

Travel, accommodation, and related expenses will be fully covered by the project.

The working language of the workshop is English.

Application procedure

Applications must include the following documents:

- Application Form (Annex 1), duly completed, signed, and scanned;
- Transcript of records (or self-certification) for all completed university courses;
- Motivation letter in English, signed and scanned;
- English language proficiency (certificate if available);
- CV.

All documentation must be sent via email to cettina.santagati@unict.it by 17 April 2026 at 12:00 AM.

Only applications received by the deadline and meeting the eligibility criteria will be considered.

It is possible that the students will be asked for an interview with professor Cettina Santagati.

Selected candidates must confirm their participation by 29 April 2026. Once participation is confirmed, in case of withdrawal, a penalty fee may be charged by the travel agency for changing the ticket.

Selection criteria

- Motivation letter
- CV
- Academic record
- English language certification

Having passed the *Parametric Modeling Digital Survey* exam with a minimum grade of 28/30 is considered a preferred requirement.
